

NOTICE 002/2024/PROPE/ASSIN FOREIGN VISITING RESEARCHER
SCHOLARSHIP - BPV I

The Graduate Program in Psychology at the Federal University of São João Del-Rei (UFSJ) hereby announces the criteria for the selection of international visiting researchers to the Program, according to the Notice 02/2024/PROPE/ASSIN. In addition to meeting all the criteria required in the mentioned document, interested researchers or their representatives in the program must submit their application to the PPGPSI via email. The ranking of applicants will consider compliance with the requirements of the position notice, as well as criteria for ranking the candidates in accordance with the notice, as follows:

1. Application for the scholarship should be done via email to the PPGPSI (ppgpsi@ufs.edu.br) by April 18, 2024.
2. The selection process will be carried out by an admission committee appointed by the PPGPSI board for this purpose.
3. The candidate for the visiting professor scholarship or the program professor who will host them must, necessarily, submit the following documents:
 4.
 - 3.1 Form completed and signed by the candidate for the Visiting Researcher scholarship (according to Annex I of the mentioned notice).
 - 3.2 *Curriculum Vitae* of the Visiting Researcher: an electronic document of the academic *curriculum* (in their native foreign language and a simple translation into Portuguese).
 - 3.3 Work Plan to be carried out by the Visiting Researcher at the PPGPSI: activities to be performed, relevance, contribution, and expected results should be indicated (signed by the visiting researcher).
4. The admission criteria will the candidates ranking will be as follows:
5.
 - 4.1 Academic production of scientific articles published between 2020 and 2024 (A1= 10 points, A2= 8 points, A3 = 6 points, A4= 4 points, B1= 2 points, other classifications will not be scored). In case of journals without Qualis classification, the Program will use the Journal Citation Reports (JCR) for the field; (the highest position in the ranking will score 20 points and the others will be calculated by simple proportion);
 - 4.2 Strategic research line that supports the research programs of the PPGPSI (10 points, if consonant with the research lines and 0 points for lack of consonance);

- 4.3 Ranking of the home institution, according to the Center for World University Rankings (CWUR) (the highest position in the ranking will score 10 points and the others will be calculated by simple proportion);
- 4.4 Suitability and coherence of the Work Plan with the PPGPSI's needs and the period of permanence at UFSJ (0 to 10 points).
5. The final grade will be calculated by the simple sum of the candidate's scores in each item.
 6. The PPGPSI selection committee will make a final list of classified candidates in order of classification, according to the criteria above.
 7. The list of candidates will be sent to PROPE, which will proceed with the admission process.
